Total Funding = \$4,366.99

Additional breathalyzers purchased by participating locations: 1,440 units

Free promotional breathalyzers: 10 boxes = 1,000 breathalyzers (BOGO offers etc.)

The Iron Horse Bar & Grill, Bodega/Monks, and Press Box all required x2 resources because of the number of restrooms and serving bars. That means Think Twice delivered 2 media kits and 2 boxes of breathalyzers to each location during onboarding.
